



## Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understandings between LSi and CBA/CNU to engage in academic collaboration related to small and medium enterprise (SME) management.

### Background

This MOU will serve to establish the partners' mutual interest in collaborating on activities including, but not limited to, faculty and student exchanges, study tours, short courses, and research.

## Reporting

Monitoring and evaluation of this MOU will be carried out by the Deputy Director and Dean of the International Relations Office of LSi and the Dean of the CBA/CNU.

## Funding

This MOU does not commit either partner to the expenditure of funds.

### Duration

This MOU is at-will and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from LSi and CBA/CNU. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from LSi and CBA/CNU and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the partners by mutual consent.
