Timor-Leste and LSi Business School Further Develop Collaboration

Reciprocal visits were made by His Excellency Ermenegildo Kupa Lopes, Ambassador of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste to the Kingdom of Cambodia and delegates of LSi Business School. His Excellency visited 13 March 2023, while a delegation from LSi, led by its director, Dr. Hem Bonarin, visited the Embassy on 21 March 2023. The purpose of the visits was to explore the potential for cooperation between the Embassy, educational institutions in Timor-Leste and LSi Business School.

Cooperation will be facilitated by direct flights between Dili and Phnom Penh beginning in the near future. Timor Leste will invite LSi Business School to visit the country to further explore possibilities of cooperation. It is expected that there will be student

and teacher exchange between Timor Leste and Cambodia after that.



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The Visit of PACT Cambodia to LSi Business School



At the invitation of LSi Business School, Ms. Sabine Joukes, Chief of Party, and Ms. Peng Lody, Deputy Chief of Party, of PACT Cambodia paid a visit to LSi Business School on 10 March 2023. The purpose of the visit was to exchange information between the two institutions and to discuss the possibilities of future cooperation between LSi Business School and PACT Cambodia.

Ms. Sabine Joukes addressed sincere thanks to LSi Business School for a warm welcome and provided an introduction to PACT Cambodia. PACT Cambodia has worked for years starting from 1991 until now to improve the lives of Cambodians, including helping local communities to build better livelihoods, enjoy more responsive and accountable governance, and responsibly manage the country's natural resources and environment. PACT mainly focuses on development of the health sector, governance, civil rights, and entrepreneurship.

After the meeting, Ms. Sabine and Ms. Lody delivered a lecture about the We ACT Project (Women Entrepreneurs Act in Cambodia), which is a five-year project funded by USAID to support young women in Cambodia's urban centers to realize their path toward empowerment and success as entrepreneurs and leaders in their communities.



The Management Team Visits Young Entrepreneurs' Association of Cambodia



At the invitation of Young Entrepreneurs Association of Cambodia (YEAC), the management team of LSi Business School, led by Dr. Susan Hagadorn, Deputy Director, paid a visit to this organization on 1 March 2023. The purpose of the visit was to explore more about each other and to discuss the possibilities for further cooperation between LSi Business School and YEAC.

Mr. Bun Sambath, Secretary General of YEAC, briefed the LSi delegation about YEAC's mission, its capacity, and its role in the trade sector in Cambodia. Then, he discussed the role of YEAC at the national and regional level. At the national level, YEAC joins a number of working groups comprised of government and private sector such as a working group on finance led by the Cambodia Chamber of Commerce and a Diplomacy Economic working group lead by Mr. Prak David from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cambodia. At the regional level, YEAC is a member of the ASEAN Young Entrepreneurs Council and a member of Global Entrepreneurs. YEAC is working with groups of entrepreneurs from China, Japan, and Singapore.

Dr. Susan Hagadorn, Deputy Director of LSi Business School, introduced the history of LSi Business School and provided information about its academic degree programs. Ms. Chim Manavy addressed LSi Business Schools' interest in cooperation with YEAC in the form of internships, scholarships, and other forms of cooperation that are beneficial to both institutes. In this regard, Ms. Manavy invited Mr. Bun Sambath and the management team of YEAC to visit LSi Business School at their convenient time for further discussion on the future cooperation of the two institutions.



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Liger Leadership Academy Holds Climate Change Program at LSi Business School



LSi Business School was pleased to serve as host to the Liger Leadership Academy for the final event of its Climate Challenge Action Project. Organized by students for students, the program featured presentations and group discussions about the role of youth to improve the environment and reverse the effects of climate change. Nine innovative, student-led projects were presented to three judges from youth environmental organizations. In the end, three teams won the championship:

- EcoWarriors created water blobs made of seaweed to reduce the use of plastic packaging.
- The Fighters founded a youth awareness campaign providing multiple engagement programs such as documentary screenings, field trips, and creative climate-related competitions.
- Envopro developed a futuristic trash bin that uses a sensor to detect and divide trash thrown into the bins.

Two additional teams received honorable mentions:

- Metamorphic Rock developed a 3D model of a machine that converts carbon dioxide exhausted from cars into oxygen using ultraviolet light.
- The Pollinators created workshops for public schools on waste management.
